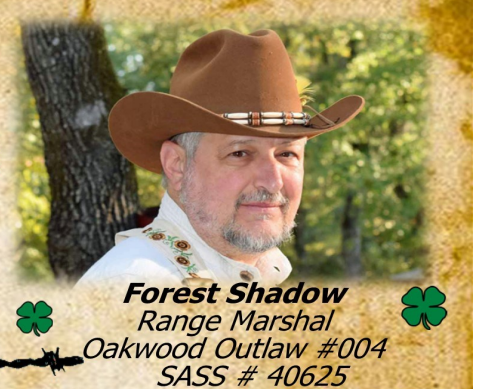

The rest of the weekend the weather was great! Texas Tommy Gun shot with us again and even earned the Justa Hand Award for Saturday's Match. It was good to see him again, it has been a few months. We also had a St. Patty's Day side match which Tommy Reb won after shooting clean in the match. Congrats Reb, hope you enjoy the "Liquid Gold" coffee mug. Fallingblock also shot clean that day. We also had a little Movie Line Trivia Contest and Jake Cutter took home the prize with all 18 answers correct, and some of the lines were tough. For his movie knowledge he won a John Wayne movie pack.

On Sunday, we had six shooters and three of them shot clean, Fallingblock, Ms. Laurie Darlin' and Oklahoma Dee and there was no bonus target to eliminate misses that match.
